

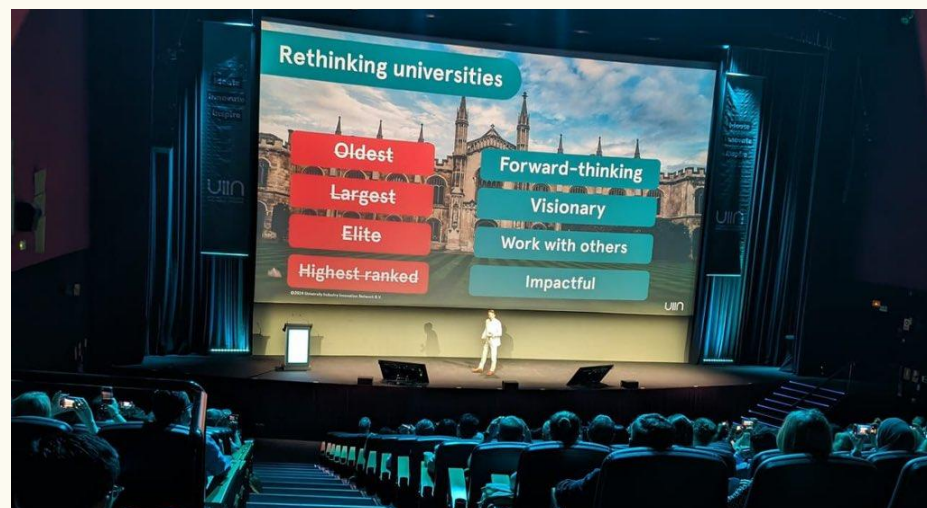
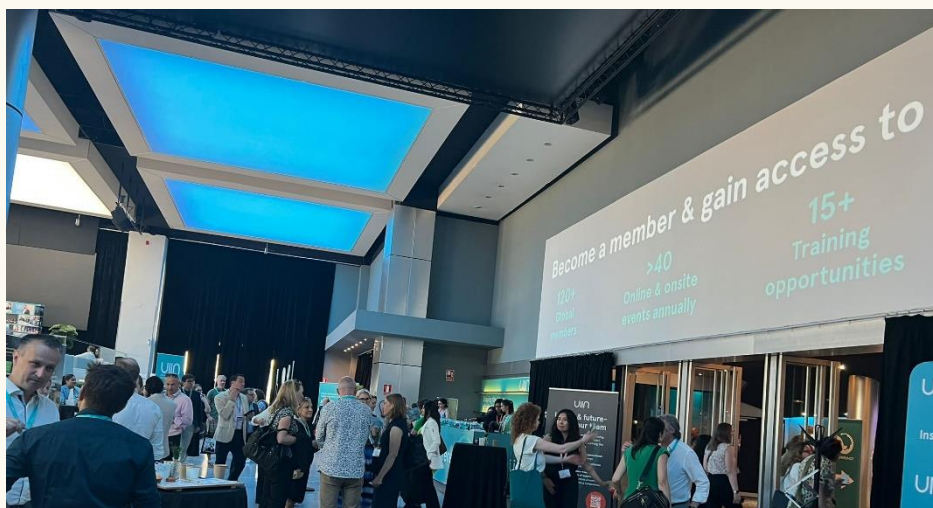

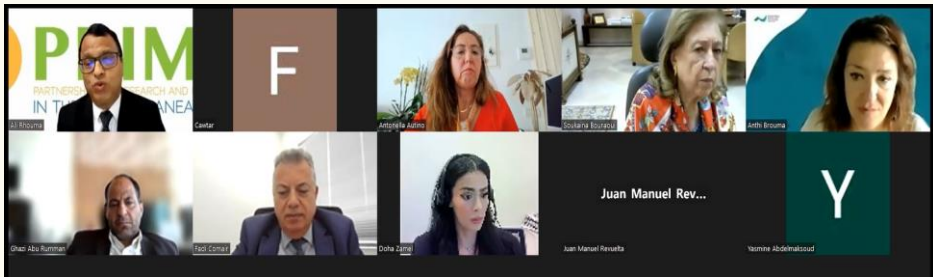
Arab Open University in Jeddah organizes "AOU Carnival" event – Jeddah, Saudi Arabia
