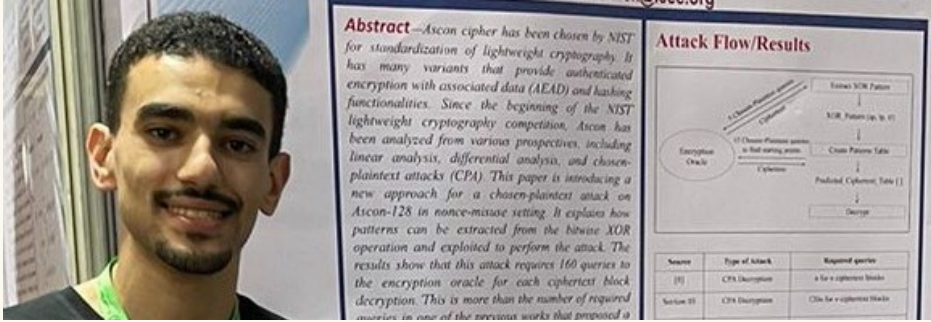
### The Arab Open University chives remarkable success in Round University Ranking 2024 - Egypt
